What We Have Been Doing We have been learning about Spring, growing plants, animal life cycles, habitats and food chains. Children have been exploring and growing spring flowers, and watching tadpoles develop into frogs and cater-pillars change into butterflies.

Ofsted Thank you for your contributions to our Ofsted inspection last term. Our inspection report has been published and we have been graded 'good'. Thank you and congratulations to our wonderful team. The report can be read online https://reports.ofsted.gov.uk/provider/16/EY556679 and we have printed copies available to read at nursery. The report highlights positive features of our practice, environment and procedures. We are already working towards the recommendations of our report by improving consistency across the nursery, and by adapting the Safari room to support the children, staff and parents to have ownership of the Safari room which is shared with the out of school club. We have also added an outdoors display board and ordered a sign to help parents to locate this room. We welcome further feedback and suggestions, and Safari parents are welcome to arrange a visit with Vicki, Radka or Shane to see these changes in person.

Staff News Vicki, Radka and Shane are temporarily sharing the role of room leader for the Safari room. Vicki has taken over the nursery teacher role in addition to her nursery manager role, but Radka will continue to work with Vicki as our education/ curriculum champion. We have welcomed Amy to the Safari room team, and Jade and Becky to the Sea room team. The staff team attended two staff development days in April which boosted their knowledge, understanding and application of pedagogy, and enabled them to individually assess their knowledge of safeguarding, health and safety at work and special educational needs and disabilities, so they could revise their areas of uncertainty. Vicki has completed 'an introduction to forest school' and 'curriculum in the early years' training.
